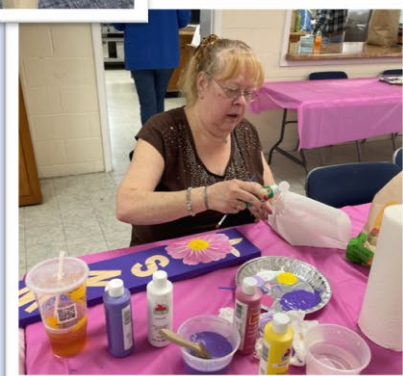
Mr. Miller Goes to Reno
