#### **OTHER NEWS**

As part of the VDG CHALLENGE #1, the Westminster Lions collected 18 pillows, 14 bed sets, 25 sheet sets and 13 blankets during VDG Challenge I for SLEEP IN HEAVENLY PEACE. Lions had a chance to tour the donation drop off site. Thank you to all who donated and served in this wonderful collection to ensure that no child sleeps on the floor.

Lion Barb coordinated donations of more than 100 pajamas from both the Westminster Lions Club and Mount Zion United Methodist Church in Finksburg! The PJs have been donated to JOSH'S JAMMIES, a non-profit organization that

collects new pajamas for hospitalized children. The organization was started in 2015 by 12-year-old Josh Holmes because he wanted children to be as comfortable as possible while receiving treatment in the hospital. Josh's mother received the donation at Chestnut Ridge Volunteer Fire Company in Owings Mills.


